The new ŠKODA flagship had an impressively staged debut with the world premiere of the specially composed 'Superb Symphony', performed by the renowned Czech Philharmonic Orchestra. The 'Superb Symphony' was composed by the Hungarian-German musician and music producer Leslie Mandoki.


