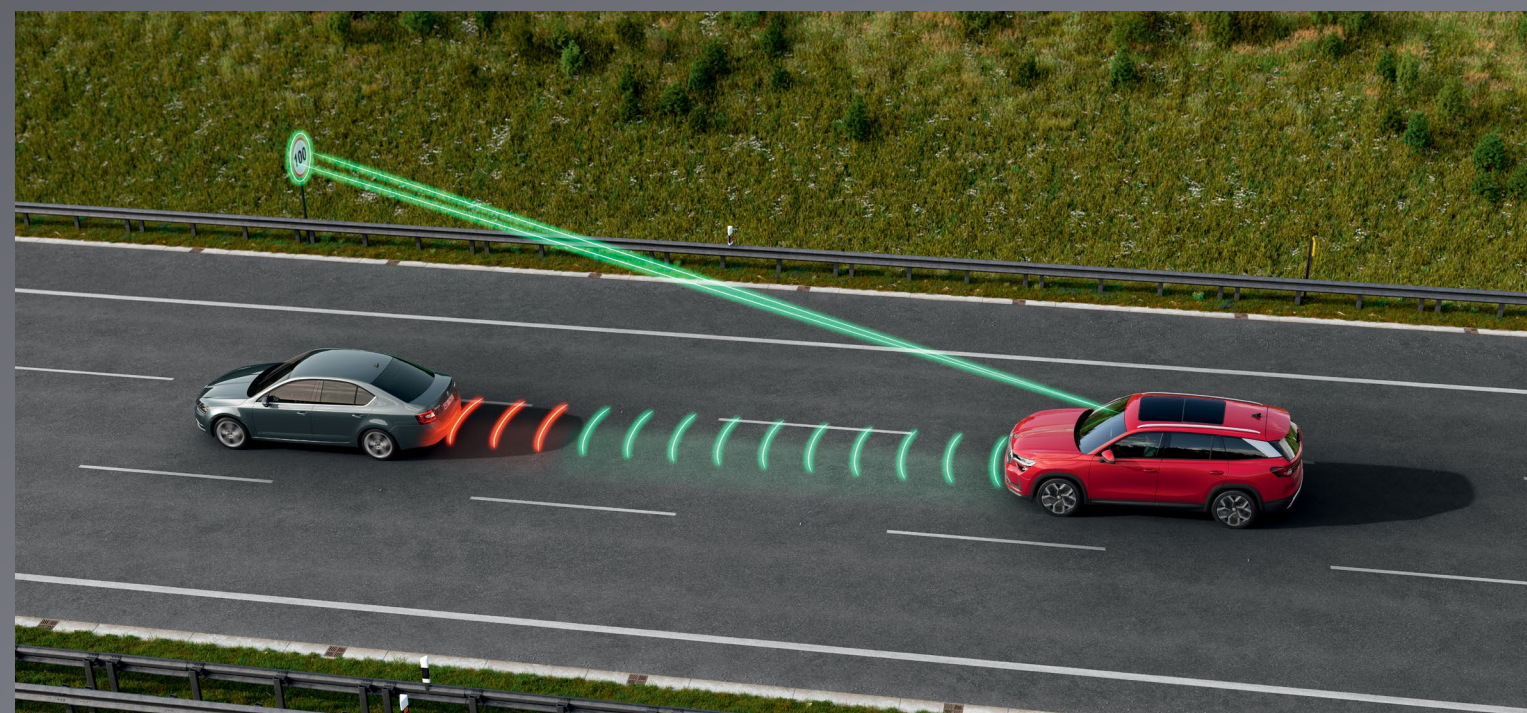

New assistance systems



Intelligent Speed Assist

Traffic Sign Recognition has been extended to include new functions and is now called Intelligent Speed Assist (ISA). ISA detects road signs and uses navigation data to help drivers observe speed limits.



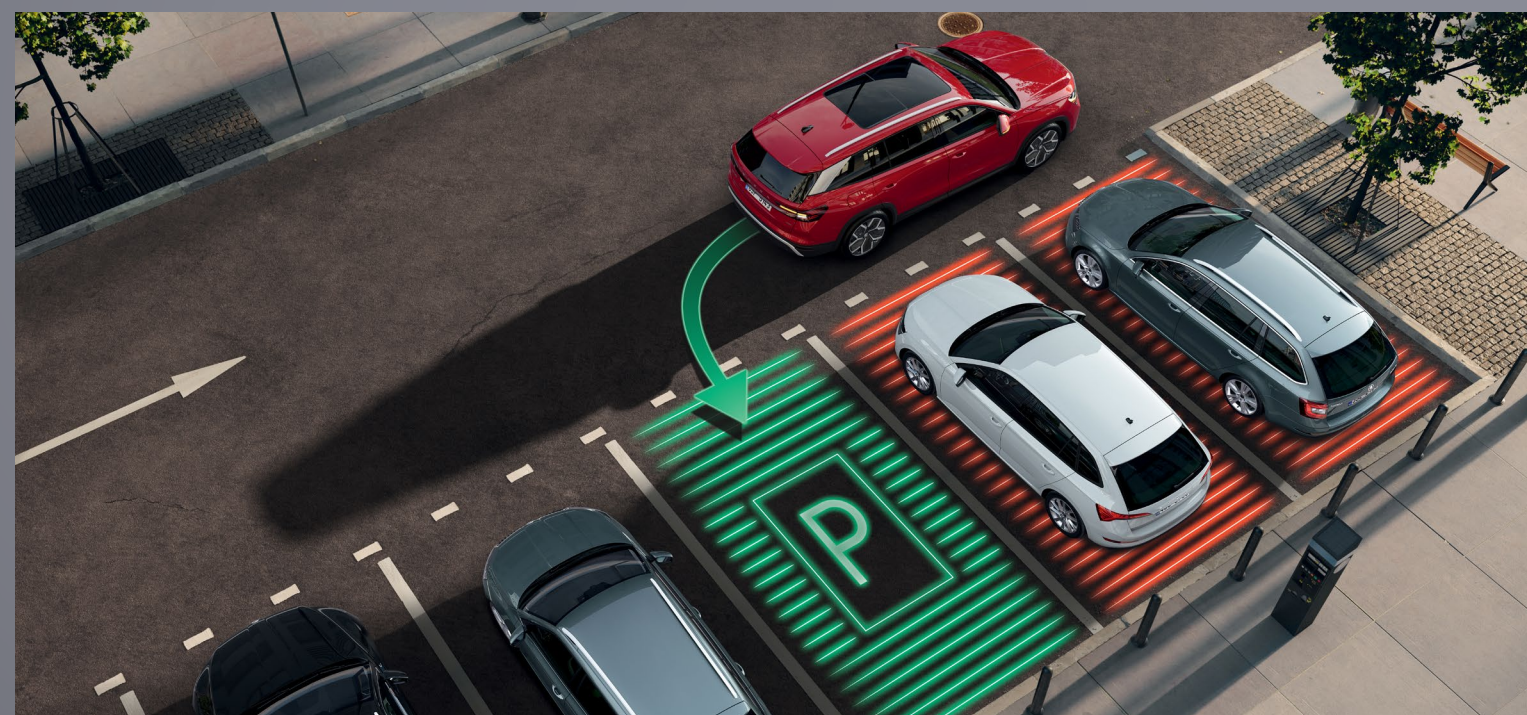
Turn Assist and Crossroad Assist

Enhanced safety with Turn Assist and Crossroad Assist: Proactively monitoring junctions and oncoming traffic, these systems alert and autonomously brake to prevent collisions during turns and at obstructed views, ensuring safe manoeuvres at speeds up to 30 km/h.



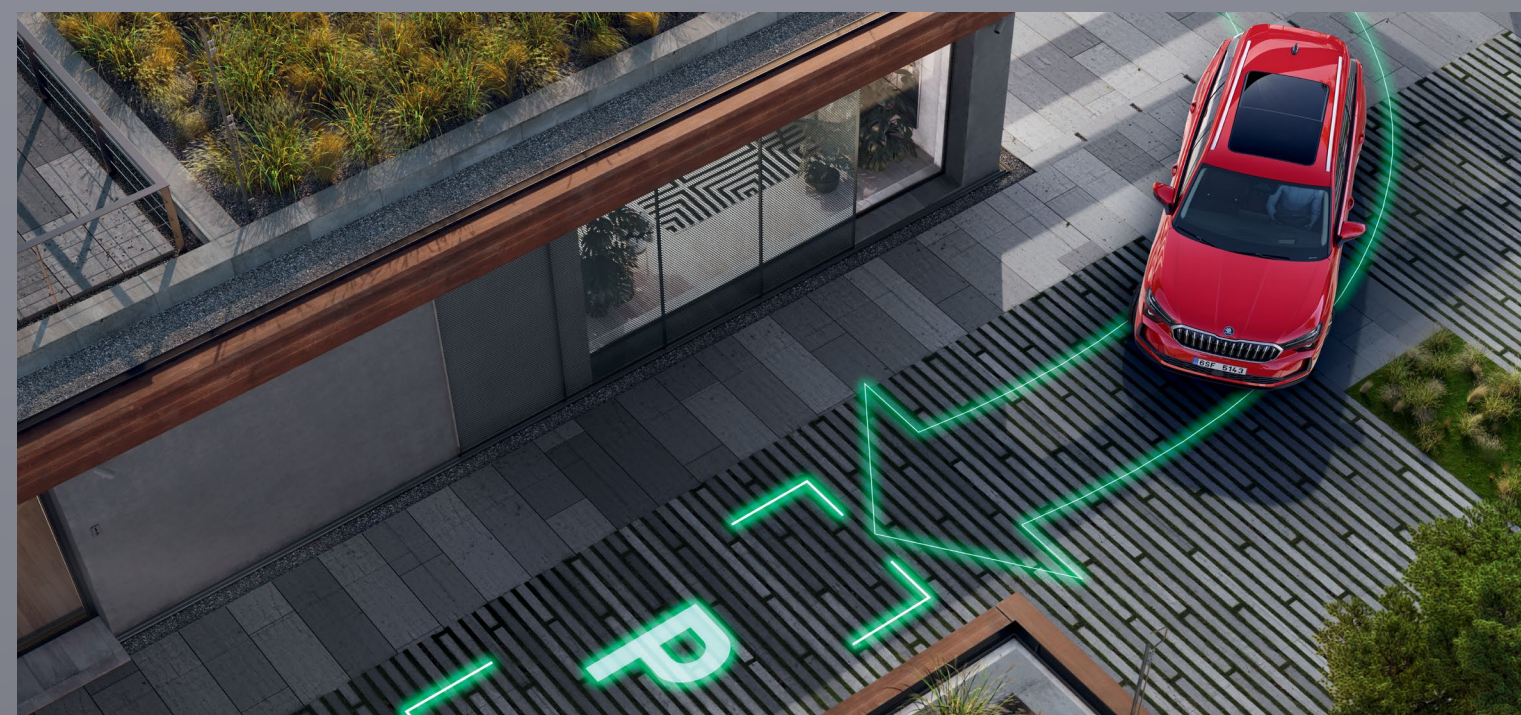
Exit Warning

This system alerts drivers and passengers, through visual (Side Assist warning light in the wing mirror) and audible warnings, before exiting a parallel-parked car to prevent door collisions with vehicles, cyclists, motorcyclists, electric scooters, or joggers.



Intelligent Park Assist

This system helps the driver to park the car in a row of vehicles parked parallel or perpendicular to the road and to exit from a parallel parking place. Intelligent Park Assist controls the steering wheel, the brakes, the accelerator, and the direction of travel (forwards and backwards).



Trained Parking

This feature automates parking manoeuvres in familiar locations, e.g. at home.



Remote Parking

This system is used to automatically park the car in a row of vehicles parked parallel or perpendicular to the road and to exit from a parallel parking place. The user stands outside the car and controls it remotely via the MyŠkoda app. (available later)
