## Škoda Epiq

The all-electric SUV crossover at a glance

> 3 power variants, ranging from **85 to 155 kW**

> 2 traction-battery versions: **38.5 and 55 kWh** (gross capacity)

> range: up to around **440 km**

> DC charging time from 10 to 80%: in **approx. 24 min**

> low drag coefficient:  **$c_d = 0.275$**

> luggage space: **475 l**


## Volkswagen Navarra plant Important Facts

 **10,000,000+** Volkswagen models produced since 1984

 Nearly **5,000** employees

 Production capacity of over **1,400** vehicles/day

 1 vehicle produced **every 54.6 s**

 Changes in the production line, including expansion of the body shop



## Volkswagen Navarra plant Milestones

- 1965** • Founded as a car factory **Authi** (Automóviles de Turismo Hispano-Ingleses) to produce British licenced models
- 1975** • Production of **SEAT** models begins
- 1984** • Volkswagen era begins, with several generations of the popular **Polo** produced at the plant
- 2020s** • Production program includes modern SUVs **T-Cross** and **Taigo**
- 2025** • Plant produces its **10-millionth Volkswagen** vehicle
- The production line updated to assemble both **ICE** and **BEV** models
- 2026** • Production of the all-electric Škoda **Epiq** and Volkswagen **ID. Cross** SUVs starts
